Three new towns – East Granby, Granby and Simsbury – have been added to the municipalities where residents need to follow the schedule shown here for irrigating no more than twice a week.

The schedule enables residents to keep lawns and gardens healthy without overwatering and needlessly lowering water levels in the reservoirs and wells serving them.
