Clean Water: It's A Main Event

It's kind of hard to believe that systems like Aquarion's with millions of gallons of crystal-clear water flowing through them ever need cleaning. But the fact is they do. And to keep that water crystal-clear, it needs to happen more often than you'd expect.

Over the coming months, Aquarion crews will be out in force in many areas, cleaning out our water mains to remove natural mineral deposits that build up over time. This may discolor your water service for a brief period. To help you plan for that, we'll run ads in local newspapers. If you've signed up for Aquarion Alerts, powered by Everbridge, we'll also notify you through an automated phone call. That will give you time to put some extra drinking and cooking water in your refrigerator.



Once cleaning is complete, you may notice some discoloration in your tap water. You can usually clear that simply by running your cold-water faucets for about 15 minutes. That will also help keep sediments out of your hot water tank.

Irrigation Schedule Begins In Fairfield

Inefficient use of irrigation has led to a twice-weekly schedule on sprinkler system usage in nine Connecticut towns. This year, we are asking Fairfield customers to voluntarily follow our schedule in preparation for a mandatory schedule in 2022.

That makes right now the best time for our Fairfield customers to start developing the habit of watering a maximum of two days each week.

So far, Aquarion customers have saved over two billion gallons of water by simply following the schedule.
