We Dig Spring

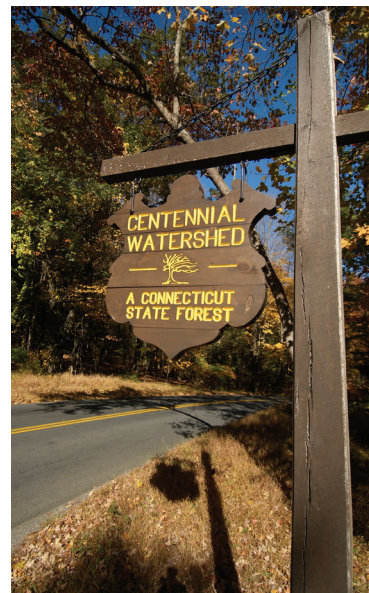
Warm weather opens up Aquarion's busiest season for keeping our pumps, water mains, treatment plants and other facilities in top shape, so we can continue providing you with safe, reliable water service.



For example, in Stamford, we've launched a year-long project that will upgrade local water distribution by building a new pump station at the corner of Halliwell Drive and Sycamore Terrace. In Greenwich, we're replacing almost ¾ of a mile of water mains for customers on Woodland Drive, Keofferam Road and Hawthorne Road. In Westport, we'll be completing landscaping at the site of our two new water storage tanks we installed on North Avenue.
