


Water Supply Update

Weather Trends/Outlook

Precipitation totaled 6.13 inches in January. This amount was significantly more than the long-term average of 3.5 inches. However, over the last twelve months it has evened out as the precipitation level as dropped back down to slightly above the long-term average. Millbury and Oxford are currently at Drought Level 0 – Normal.
