


## *Water Supply Update Serving the Communities of Millbury and Oxford*

### Weather Trends/Outlook

Precipitation totaled 4.16 inches in March. This amount is the exact same as the average in the month of March. Even though over the last six months there has been a slightly above average amount of precipitation, Millbury and Oxford still finished below the average amount of precipitation during this past year. Millbury and Oxford are currently at Drought Level 0 – Normal.




