

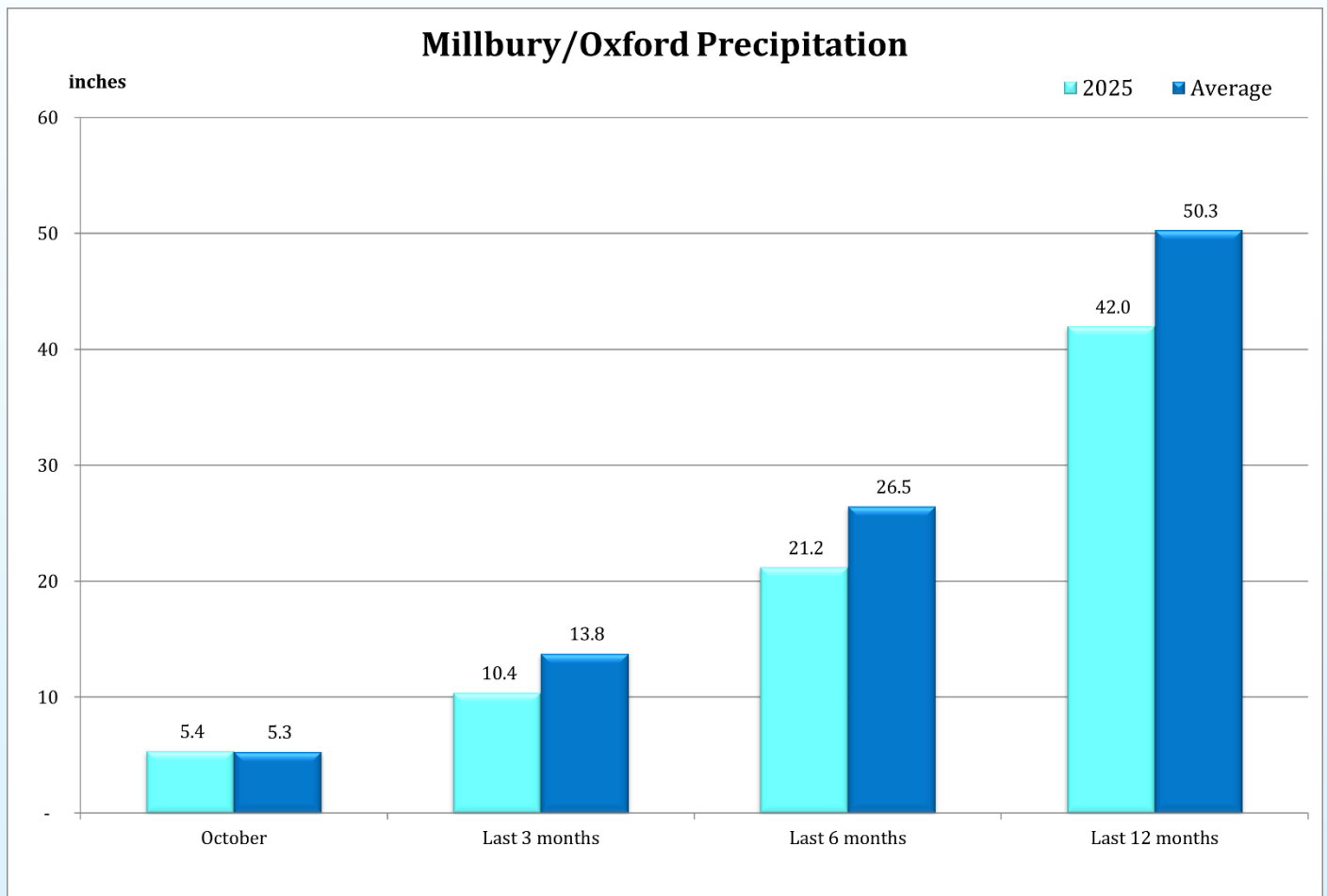


Water Supply Update

Serving the Communities of Millbury and Oxford

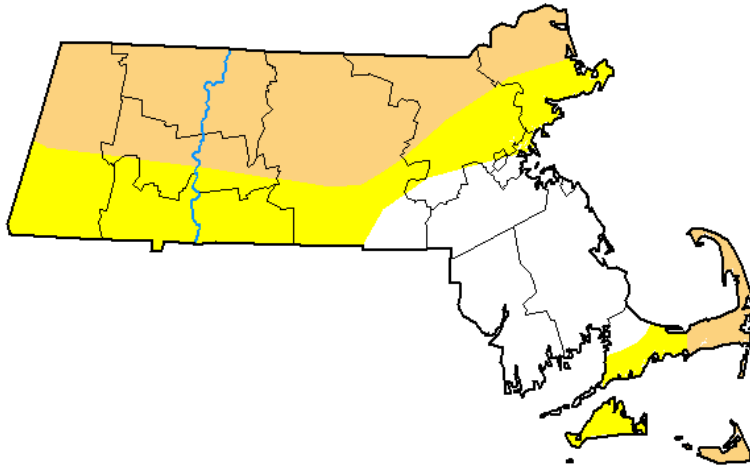
Weather Trends/Outlook

Precipitation totaled 5.4 inches in October. This amount was slightly more than the long-term average of 5.32 inches. However, in the last twelve months, Millbury/Oxford has seen substantially less precipitation than an average year for this region. Millbury and Oxford are currently at Drought Level 0 – Abnormally Dry.
