

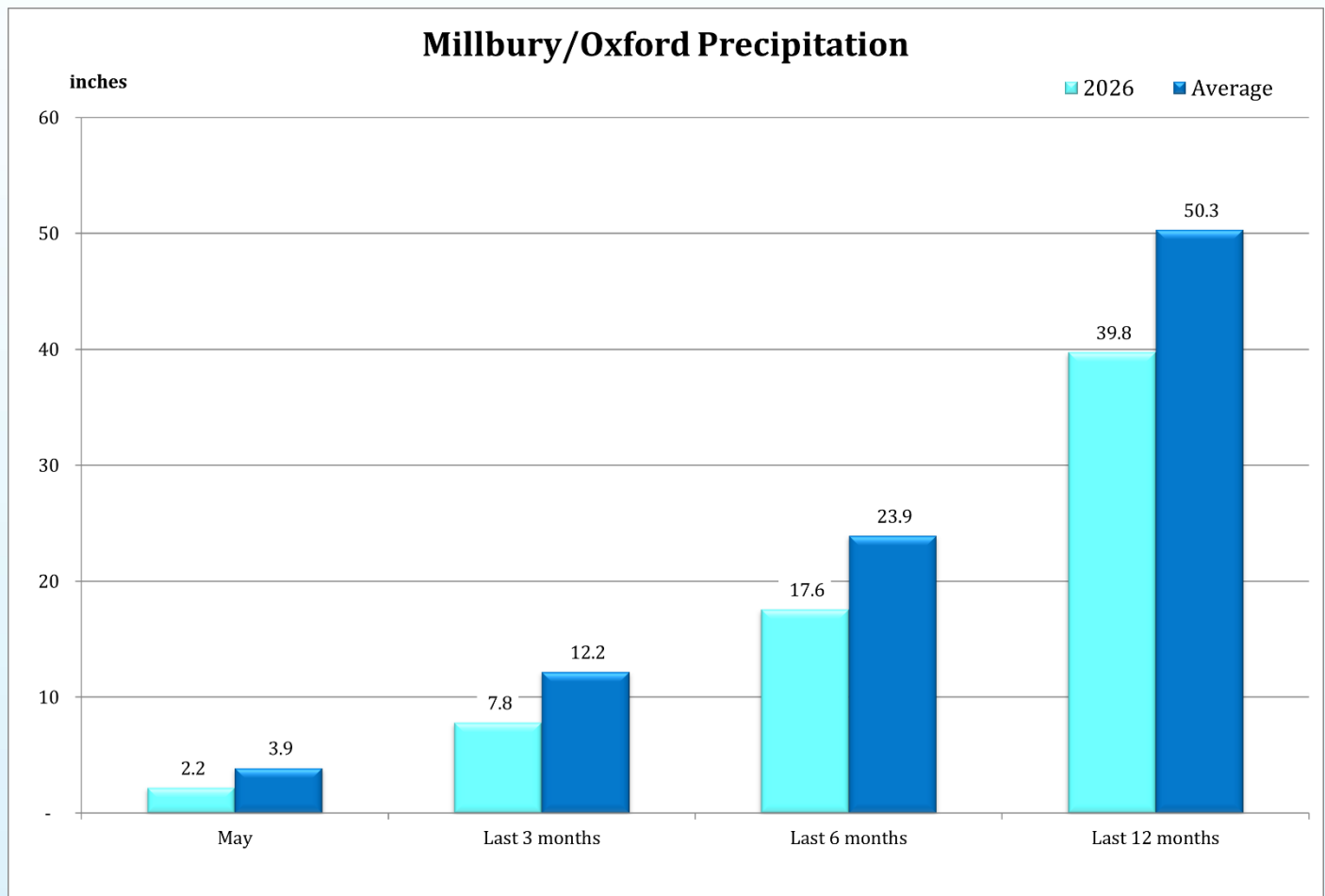


Water Supply Update

Serving the Communities of Millbury and Oxford

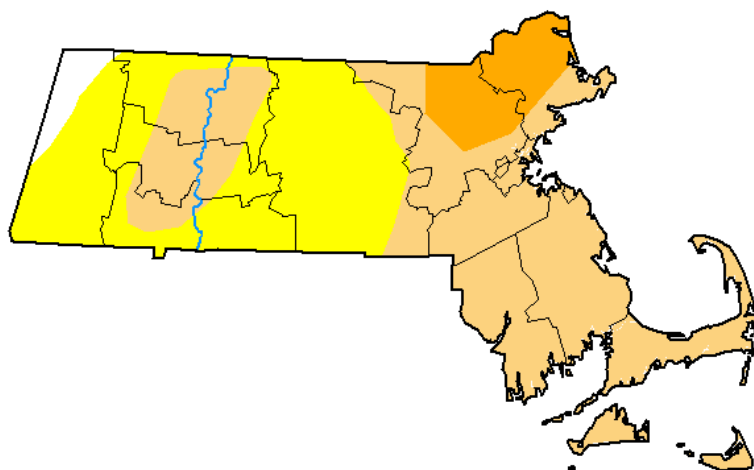
Weather Trends/Outlook

Precipitation totaled 2.2 inches in May. This amount was less than the long-term average of 3.9 inches. However, in the last twelve months, Millbury/Oxford has seen substantially less precipitation than an average year for this region. Millbury and Oxford are currently at Drought Level D0 – Abnormally Dry.
