


Water Supply Update

Serving the Communities of Hampton, North Hampton, & Rye

Weather Trends/Outlook

Precipitation in March totaled 3.6 inches compared to the long term average of 3.9 inches. Over the past 12 months, total precipitation is 1.2 inches below average. Average monthly temperature was 35°F; matching the historical average.

No current drought conditions on the Seacoast. No local water use restrictions.




