


Water Supply Update

Weather Trends/Outlook

Precipitation in April totaled 5.1 inches compared to the long term average of 4.6 inches. Over the past 12 months, total precipitation is 0.4 inches above average. Average monthly temperature was 44°F, which is 1°F below the historical average.

Current Water Use Restrictions
