


# Water Supply Update

*Serving the Communities of Hampton, North Hampton, & Rye*

## Weather Trends/Outlook

Precipitation in February totaled 3.2 inches compared to the long term average of 3.5 inches. Over the past 12 months, total precipitation is 1.8 inches below average. Average monthly temperature was 32°F, which is 6°F above the historical average.

## Current Water Use Restrictions

Currently, there are no drought conditions or water use restrictions on the Seacoast.
