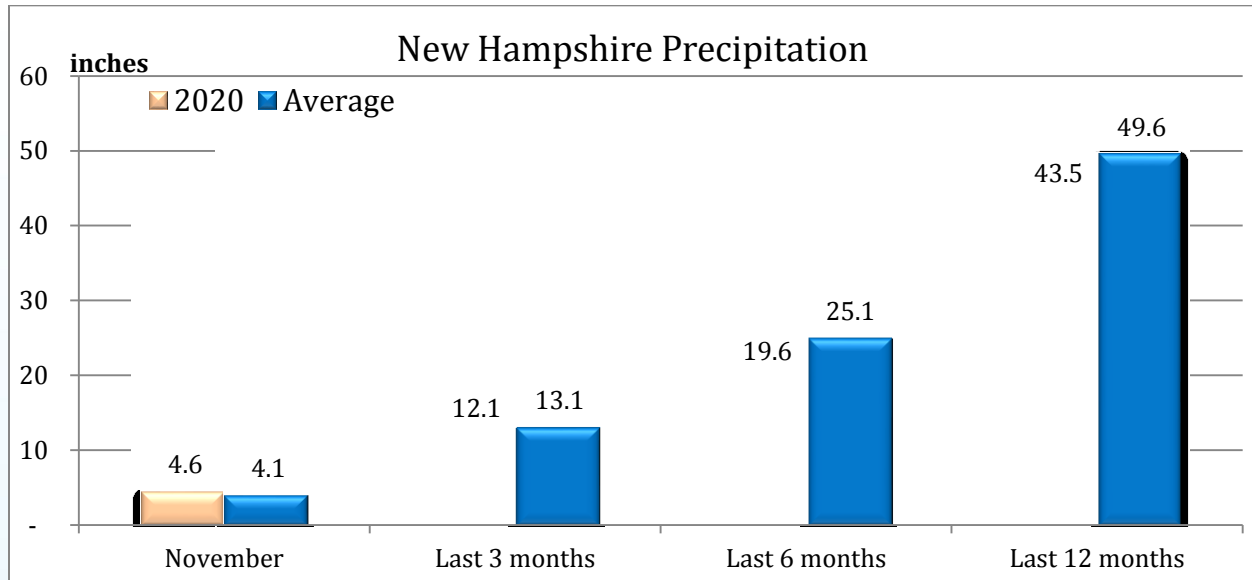


# Water Supply Update

*Serving the Communities of Hampton, North Hampton, & Rye*

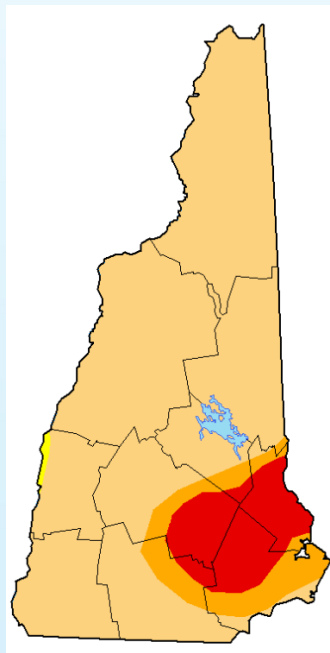
## Weather Trends/Outlook

Drought conditions continue to persist on the seacoast, but moderated as more average rainfall occurred in November. Monthly precipitation was 4.6 inches; compared to the average of 4.1 inches.



## Current Water Use Restrictions

The U.S. Drought Monitor (<https://droughtmonitor.unl.edu>) currently shows **Moderate to Severe Drought** conditions on the New Hampshire seacoast. However, supplies are adequate to meet demand and there are no restrictions are currently in place.
